




## Windshield Washer Solvent Container and Pump Replacement

## **Removal Procedure**



**Important:** Do not disconnect the brake lines from the master cylinder.

- 1. Remove the master cylinder. Refer to Master Cylinder Replacement in Hydraulic Brakes.
- 2. Set the master cylinder aside.
- 3. Remove the bolt from the washer solvent container.



- 4. Lift the washer solvent container up enough to access the washer hose and the electrical connector.
- 5. Disconnect the washer hose from the washer pump.
- 6. Disconnect the electrical connector from the washer pump.
- 7. Remove the washer solvent container from the vehicle.






8. Remove the washer pump from the washer solvent container.

## **Installation Procedure**



1. Install the washer pump in the washer solvent container.





Connect the electrical connector to the washer pump.

- 3. Connect the washer hose to the washer pump.
- 4. Position the washer solvent container into the locating holes in the chassis.





Notice: Refer to Fastener Notice in Cautions and Notices.

5. Install the washer solvent container with the bolt.

Tighten:

Tighten the bolt to 10 [n-m] (89 lb in).

6. Install the master cylinder. Refer to Master Cylinder Replacement in Hydraulic Brakes.
